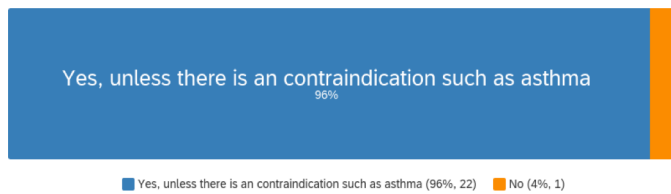
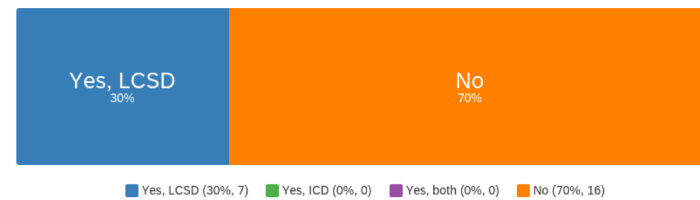


CASE 1 SURVEY RESULTS

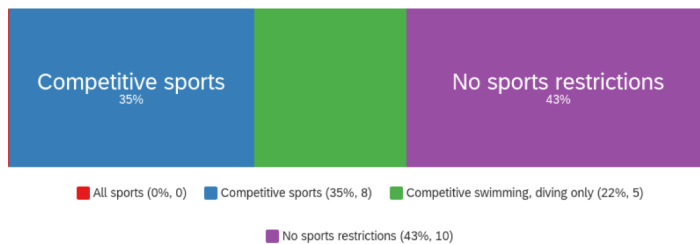
Q1 - Case 1, this patient, assuming that after a period of deconditioning and additional testing you are convinced he has LQTS should be treated with a beta blocker?
